After working with Morrissey Construction and Mason's Landscaping, an 8(a) certified, minority owned firm, to create an 8(a) joint venture company, the IL PTAC at John A. Logan College has assisted the newly formed joint venture in taking advantage of the 8(a) certification and the opportunities available to them.

Need for Services:

Scott Air Force Base located in Shiloh, IL issued a sources sought for a Multiple Award Construction Contract in early Spring of 2009. The eventual RFP was issued as a small business set aside, historically the RFP had been issued for full and open competition. 2M Construction Group expressed their interest in the opportunity and began to prepare a proposal. In the weeks and months involved with the proposal preparation, the IL PTAC at John A Logan provided assistance in RFP review and proposal preparation and review. We communicated with contracting officers, upon client's request, regarding the enforcement of the Small Business Size Standards for this small business set aside to help ensure that the contractors chosen would fall within the Small Business Size Standards developed by SBA.

Goals and Objectives:

2M Construction Group is one of 10 contractors falling into the small business size category who will be competing for construction projects on base for the next year with 4-one year renewal options.

Scope:

2 M Construction Group is an 8(a) joint venture formed by Morrissey Construction Inc and Mason's LCS, Inc. Shortly after the joint venture received approval from the SBA, it was awarded a sole source

contract with the National Park Service for a roofing project at the Lincoln Home National Historic Site. This is the first federal contract for the joint venture and for each of the parties involved. The scope of this project is as follows: furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, necessary supervision to install new wood shingle and metal roofing, lead-coated copper gutter system, and chimney repair on the Robinson and Cook Homes located at the Lincoln Historic Site in Springfield, Illinois. The PTAC assisted 2M with the joint venture formation as well as providing bid history research for the sole source contract as well as assistance in the communication between the National Park Service and the company.
